

LUIS PATO MARIA GOMES ESPUMANTE BRUTO NV \$64 Medium Body, White plum, Lemon, White blossoms, Toast
Wine production has been a Pato family tradition since at least the 18th century. Crafted using the traditional Champenoise method, Luis Pato's Maria Gomes sparkling white wine blends the elegance of Maria Gomes (95%) with a touch of Sercialinho (5%). The result is a stunning sparkler.
LUIS PATO VINHA PAN ESPUMANTE 2020 Magnum (1.50L) \$190 Orange zest, Hazelnut, Toast, Brioche
Wine production has been a Pato family tradition since at least the 18th century. This wine is a Blanc des Noirs style crafted entirely from Baga grapes and offers a captivatingly complex and deep aroma. Vegan, no added Sulfites, Sustainable Viticulture.
LUIS PATO VINHA FORMAL ESPUMANTE 2014 Magnum (1.50L) \$190 Peach, Apricot, Brioche, Toast
Luis Pato is one of Portugal's most celebrated and innovative winemakers, renowned for his work with the indigenous grape variety Baga. This wine is made from 100% Baga grapes in the Moinho vineyard.
SIDÓNIO DE SOUSA SPECIAL CUVEÉ 2019 \$64 Fresh, Green Apple, Lime, Wet Stones, Yeast
Sidónio de Sousa is recognized for having amongst the oldest Baga vines in Bairrada. He continues to make wine in the traditional way using the Champenois method for his sparklers, resulting in elegant, age-worthy wines. This wine is produced with free-run juice only from Bical, Maria Gomes, and Arinto varietals.



DOURO VALLEY

Douro Valley -Northern Portugal along the Douro River

White wines from the Douro Valley are increasingly gaining recognition for their quality and complexity. Traditionally known for its robust red wines and Port production, the Douro also offers excellent whites made primarily from indigenous grape varieties such as Rabigato, Arinto, and Viosinho

CAVES TRANSMONTANAS VÉRTICE PINOT NOIR 2012 \$172 Plum, Blueberry, Brioche, Toast, Hazelnut, Cream
João Carvalho Maia traveled to Napa Valley to learn the production methods from the world-renowned Schramsberg Vineyards. After returning to Portugal, João began Caves Transmontanas. This wine is unique for Portugal; it is produced as a monovarietal wine from an international varietal. It is complex, full bodied, with a hint of oxidation.
CAVES TRANSMONTANAS VÉRTICE MILLÉSIME 2015
João Carvalho Maia traveled to Napa Valley to learn the production methods from the world-renowned Schramsberg Vineyards. After returning to Portugal, João began Caves Transmontanas. Millésime shows a delicate bubble that is also elegant and persistent. It is creamy and smooth and offers great structure and a long-lasting finish.
UIVO PET NAT BRANCO 2022

Uivo, a rising star in the Douro Valley, has been making waves in the Portuguese wine scene since its inception in 2007. This wine is a blend of hand harvested, organically grown Arinto and Bical grapes. It undergoes a spontaneous, wild yeast fermentation, and is bottled during the fermentation process, capturing the gasses created through fermentation and adding a delightful effervescence to this wine.

WHITE WINES



VINHO VERDE

Northern Portugal

SOALHEIRO "ALLO" LOUREIRO BLEND 2023
Soalheiro has become synonymous with exceptional white wines that highlight the unique terroir of the region. This blend of Loureiro and Alvarinho is particularly noteworthy. Loureiro brings aromatic qualities, often featuring floral and citrus notes, while Alvarinho contributes structure and richness. This blend results in a refreshing yet complex wine.
PORTUGAL BOUTIQUE WINERY "GORRO" LOUREIRO 2023
The Gorro Loureiro comes from two 40-year-old vineyards just a few kilometers from the Atlantic Ocean. One vineyard on the Lima River is on schist soil, and another at a slightly higher elevation is on granite. These vineyards benefit from a unique microclimate influenced by the nearby Atlantic Ocean, preserving the grape's natural acidity and enhancing its fresh and vibrant profile.
PALÁCIO DA BREJOEIRA ALVARINHO 2023
The Palácio da Brejoeira was built in 1806. In 1964, Dona Maria Hermínia d'Oliveira Paes began planting the first hectares of Alvarinho. Since then, Alvarinho has become the flagship grape of Palácio da Brejoeira. While many Alvarinhos are enjoyed young, Palácio da Brejoeira is known for its potential to age, developing more complex flavors while maintaining its vibrant acidity.
SOALHEIRO GRANIT ALVARINHO 2023 \$93 Medium Body, Crisp, Ripe, Lemon, Grapefruit, Peach, Wet Stone, Flint
Rightfully bearing the name Granit, this wine is all about minerality. It offers less fruit and more acidity, revealing an unusual dimension of Alvarinho from the mountain. Its elegance and crisp texture make Soalheiro Granit a very gastronomic wine. <i>Vegan</i>
ANSELMO MENDES PARCELA ÚNICA ALVARINHO 2021 \$160 Medium Body, Complex, Apricot, Orange Peel, Oak, Vanilla, Butter, Smoke
Anselmo Mendes hails from the Monção and Melgaço subregion of the Vinho Verde, which is known for producing some of the best examples of this Portuguese wine style. He is affectionately known as the father of Alvarinho. This wine is a single vineyard, wood-aged wine. It is rich and smooth with a gorgeous silky texture and is regarded as a smart white Burgundy alternative showing real energy on the palate.
FORAL DE MELGAÇO VINHAS VELHAS ALVARINHO 2023 \$56 Medium Body, Rich, Concentrated, Citrus, Floral, Tropical, Brioche
Foral de Melgaço focuses on traditional winemaking methods combined with modern techniques. The old vines used for this wine often yield lower quantities but produce grapes with exceptional quality and concentration of flavor.
ANSELMO MENDES EXPRESSÕES 2021

Another gorgeous wine from Anselmo Menedes, who is affectionately known as the father of Alvarinho. This wine was produced exclusively from grapes grown in Quinta da Torre in Monção, and shows Alvarinho's creamy side as well as its mineral-driven texture.

VINHOS IMPERFEITOS "TRÊS PONTOS" BRANCO 2018
Carlos Raposo based his first solo project, Vinhos Imperfietos, on the philosophy that "small imperfections together build perfection." Since releasing his first vintage (2018), his wines have garnered the admiration of wine critics worldwide. Carlos recommends tasting this wine to the sound of "Verdes Anos" by Carlos Paredes.
VINHOS IMPERFEITOS "D&V CODE" BRANCO 2018
Vinhos Imperfeitos was born from an insatiable thirst to produce unique wines with different characteristics. D&V code was produced with grapes from two different regions: Dão and Vinhos Verdes. The goal was to put together in one bottle the best of both worlds: Deep aromatic complexity, elegance, length, and longevity from the Dão, and fresh, vibrant citrus and floral aromas from Vinho Verde. Carlos recommends tasting the wine to the sound of: "Sete pedaços de vento" by Cristina Branco.
VINHOS IMPERFEITOS "IMPERFEITO" BRANCO 2018 \$605 Medium body, Apricot, Peach, Seaweed, Gunpowder
Carlos Raposo studied in Burgundy Bordeaux and Burgundy and worked with preeminent wine producers in Sapin, Napa, and Australia before returning to Portugal. Upon his return, he worked Dirk Niepoort to produce some of the most foundational wines in Portuguese production. Vinhos Imperfeitos is a solo project of Carlos Raposo, and this is the first vintage produced. This wine was fermented in stainless steel and barrels from Puligny Montrachet, and aged in a combination of the same barrels and concrete tanks. Carlos recommends tasting the wine to the sound of "In Paradisum" by Karl Jenkins.
SOALHEIRO PRIMEIRAS VINHAS AVLARINHO 2022 \$102 Full body, Complex, Ripe, Pineapple, Mango, Butter, Nutmeg
Full body, Complex, Ripe, Pineapple, Mango, Butter, Nutmeg Soalheiro is a distinguished wine producer located in the Vinho Verde region of Portugal. It has become synonymous with exceptional white wines that highlight the unique terroir of the region. Primeiras Vinhas has a concentrated ripe fruit aroma with buttery notes and plenty of spice. Its full body perfectly balances with a crisp acidity. These complexities are due to the early ripening of the

The region of Porto was demarcated in 1761, and Quinta da Pedra Alta is the only vineyard in the Douro to have three granite markers (Marcos Pombalinos) on its property. This wine is a blend of Rabigato, which brings citrus fruits and lively acidity, and Gouveio, which brings mid palate weight with passion fruit and pineapple flavours. It is aged for 6 months spent yeast after fermentation, giving this wine texture and light pastry dough flavors. <i>Minimal Intervention</i> .
CASA FERREIRINHA PLANALTO RESERVA BRANCO 2019
Planalto is one of the most prestigious white wines from the demarcated Douro region, thanks to years of in-depth study of which grape varieties to use in their composition and how to utilize the best technology in their production. <i>Vegetarian</i>
LUIS SEABRA XISTO ILIMITADO BRANCO 2020 \$64 Medium Body, Lemon, Green Apple, Flint, Smoke, Honey
Luis Seabra works with old vineyards because he believes mature vines are more resilient and well-equipped to handle the region's intense weather. In 2013, he created the "Cru" series of wines, which revolve not around grape varieties, but vineyard sites. In Seabra's words: "We did this to show how we can put the place in the bottle." Xisto Ilimitado is a Portuguese analogue to the idea of a "village" level Burgundy. This wine is a bright and fresh introduction to the new Douro.
MAÇANITA BRANCO 2023
Brother and Sister, both winemakers, friends and business partners for more than 20 years and 18 wineries. Pursuing an old dream of a joint wine venture, Maçanita Vinhos was born. This wine is a Viosinho (indiginous grape variety) forward blend, which provides the backbone of minerality. Voisinho typically produces well-structured wines with an intense floral character, exotic fruits and lots of minerality.
PORMENOR RESERVA BRANCO 2021
One of the details insisted upon by the Pormenor Vintners is to deliver on a vision is old vines. They have found and secured scarce vineyard real estate, with vines ranging from 45 to 100+ years primarily in the Douro Superior. This wine gives minerality and freshness, but the fruit from old vines lends itself to good structure and flavor intensity.
NIEPOORT COCHE BRANCO 2020 \$237 Medium Body, Pear, White Peach, Flint, Coconut, Vanilla, Butter, Oak
Niepoort is one of the great Port houses and is now in its sixth generation of tradition and innovation. 'Coche' is an exotic and aromatic white field blend, vinified from several indigenous Portuguese varieties. It is Niepoort's most coveted wine — whose profile most resembles that of a great Burgundy. Old Vines, Sustainable, Organic, Biodynamic Viticulture, Vegan
QUINTA DA PEDRA ALTA RESERVA BRANCO 2022

Quinta da Pedra Alta is the only vineyard in the Douro to have three granite markers, which were awarded to the best land during the demarcation of the Port region in 1761. The Reserva Branco is a complex, textured, barrel fermented Douro white made from a blend of indigenous premium grape varieties from their highest vineyards.

Central Portugal

White wines from the Dão region of Portugal are known for their elegance and balance, showcasing the area's unique terroir and indigenous grape varieties. The most commonly used grapes include Encruzado, Bical, and Malvasia.

TEXTURA PURA BRANCO 2020 \$155 Light-Medium Body, Lemon, Peach, Butter, Vanilla, Oak
Textura Wines is a family project that began in 2018 in Dão, on the slopes of Serra da Estrela. Textura is one of the many projects that highlight the possibilities within Portugal. While grape varieties like Encruzado, Arinto, and Gouveio don't have the international recognition of Chardonnay, they deliver Burgundian-like wines full of character.
LAGAR DE DAREI BRANCO RESERVA 2022
Casa de Darei is a third-generation estate of the Ruivo family. The vast majority of the area is a dedicated natural reserve, with beautiful forests that line the Dão River, verdant farmland for cattle, apple orchards, and 6.8 hectares of organic certified grape vines. A sincere focus on traditionally made wines using old cement lagares (open granite troughs) and beautiful old presses makes the wines clean, focused, and speak to the area's terroir. <i>Certified Organic</i> .
QUINTA DE CABRIZ ENCRUZADO RESERVA 2022
Quinta de Cabriz is between the two main rivers in the Dão region, the Mondego and the Dão. This is one of the most famous "quintas" of the Dão region with 38 hectares of vineyards in an integrated production system and a winery equipped with the most modern wine technology.
QUINTA DE LEMOS "PICA PICA" BRANCO 2021
Chock-full of indigenous grape varieties, Quinta de Lemos designs and creates wines that express the

Chock-full of indigenous grape varieties, Quinta de Lemos designs and creates wines that express the balance between tradition and modernity, between technology and nature. Recognized for its release of older vintages, this sustainably farmed estate in the Dão showcases some of the most elegant wines from the oldest region in Portugal. *Organic and Biodynamic Viticulture*.

WORLD WINES "IDEAL" BRANCO 2021 \$89
Medium Body, Green Apple, Melon, Grass, Tomato Leaf, Oak

World Wide Wines focuses on wines from smaller, family-owned wineries, many of which produce wines in more traditional or natural styles, aiming to highlight the true essence of the regions they come from. Vegan, No Added Sulfites

TEXTURA DA ESTRELA BRANCO 2020 \$122 Medium-Full Body, Rich, Orange peel, Lemon, White Tea, Butter, Oak

Textura Wines is a family project that began in 2018 in Dão, on the slopes of Serra da Estrela. Textura Wines was born with terroir as a backbone, on the slopes of Serra da Estrela. Part production, part wine tourism, Textura conveys the honesty of the Dão. Luis Seabra is considered one of Portugal's greatest winemakers. His style emulates White Burgundy as he ages some of the wines in the same style.



BEIRA ATLÂNTICO (BAIRRADA)

Central coast, near the Atlantic

White wines from the Bairrada region of Portugal are known for their freshness, complexity, and unique character. While Bairrada is often celebrated for its red wines, particularly those made from the Baga grape, its whites are gaining recognition for their quality and distinctive profiles.

NIEPOORT VINHAS VELHAS BAIRRADA 2020
Niepoort is a family winery founded in 1842 that produces Port wines and still wines. The Niepoort VV Vinhas Velhas Branco vines are between eighty and over one hundred years old and are planted in a limestone terroir with clayey touches at almost sea level. Once the Niepoort VV Vinhas Velhas Branco is vinified, it undergoes malolactic fermentation and ages in 1,000-litre, 60-year-old Mosel foundres for about 20 months.
LUIS PATO VINHA FORMAL 2013 MAGNUM (1.50L)
Luis Pato is one of Portugal's most celebrated and innovative winemakers, renowned for his work with the indigenous grape variety Baga. This wine is made from 100% Baga grapes in the Moinho vineyard.
LUIS PATO VINHAS VELHAS BRANCO 1990 \$349 Medium Body, Orange, Lemon, Green Apple, Honey, Wet Stones,
This is the first-ever vintage of the Vinhas Velhas Branco. It is a blend of roughly equal parts of Bical, Cercial, and Sercialinho that was fermented and aged in used French oak barrels for 10 months, then held at the estate in bottles until release in 2024. The maturity of this wine is wonderfully balanced by an impressive freshness of citrus, stone fruit and hints of orange and hazelnut. This wine is slightly unfiltered.
LUIS PATO QUINTA DO RIBEIRINHO SERCIALINHO 2021
While Luis Pato is considered the Father of Baga, he dabbles in many of the indigenous varietals in Bairrada. His Quinta do Ribeirinho Sercialinho is a refreshing white wine crafted entirely from Sercial grapes, typically used in the production of Madeira. This single-varietal gem undergoes fermentation in temperature-controlled barrels, followed by aging for six months in 500-liter oak barrels.



BEIRA INTERIOR

Central Portugal

Beira Interior is less well-known than other Portuguese wine regions but has been gaining recognition for its quality wines, often showcasing the region's rich histo-ry and unique agricultural heritage. It is known for producing crisp, fresh white wines, which typically feature varieties such as Encruzado and Malvasia Fina. These wines are known for their bright acidity and citrus or floral notes.

Medium Body, Fresh, Tangy, Lemon, Green Apple, Honey, Wet Stones

Since its inception, the Beyra project has pioneered the concept of "altitude wines." They seek to combine innovation in viticulture in a region dominated by old vineyards perfectly adapted to the rigors of altitude. The slow, consistent ripening under these conditions leads to more concentrated flavors and a balanced finished product. This wine was chosen as a regional trophy at Decanter.

BEYRA "QUARTZ" RESERVA BRANCO 2021	\$48
Medium-Full Body, Bright, Crisp, Grapefruit, Saline, smoke	

This unoaked white has it all going on. It's made in one of the most remote parts of the Iberian peninsula by one of Portugal's top winemakers Rui Roboredo Madeira. This wine is produced from old vines of rare native grape varieties — Fonte Cal and Síria — are grown up a mountain near the Spanish border on granite soils packed with silex which is famed for giving that smoke and gunflint note to wines in the Loire Valley.



COLARES

Atlantic coast, near Lisbon

Full Body, Fresh, Floral, Orange, Candied Grapefruit, Saline

Wines produced in Colares are a rare and unique Portuguese delight. The Colares wine region is located in the municipality of Sintra, near Lisbon. The region is known for its exceptional, historic vineyards that are situated near the Atlantic coast, producing wines with a distinctive character. White Colares wines are typically crisp, with bright acidity. They often have notes of citrus (lemon, lime), green apple, and sometimes a touch of salinity due to the coastal terroir. These wines are known for their ability to age well, developing a rounder, more complex profile with time, often gaining a mineral edge. Older bottles might exhibit more depth and a waxy texture.

Full Body, Concentrated, Honey, Lemon, Butter, Oak, Orange Blossom Since 1937, the Ramilo family has been producing wine in one of the most privileged locations in the Lisboa region. This Malvasia from Colares is unlike any other, and Ramilo only makes a tiny amount of this wine. This Malvasia has an intensity rarely experienced before. Minerality and salinity typical of the region are completely enveloped in dominant orange blossom notes with a rich texture that simply does not end. Sustainably farmed, No added sulfites. CASAL DO RAMILO MALVASIA DE COLARES 2020 Full body, Intense, Honey, Saline, Orange Peel, Peach, Butter Another stunning wine from Casal do Ramilos. The winemaker for Casal do Ramilo replanted vines at his family's property in Colares and now owns the largest single plot in the area. This wine is a wildly complex Malvasia - Dry, oxidized with a saline note and aromas of honeycomb. It is an orange wine made by macerating 50% of the grapes on their skins in new barrique while the other half was fermented in granite lagares. Sustainably farmed, No added sulfites Full body, Orange Blossom, Saline, Oxidized This wine is a unique project from Casal do Ramilo. Their Lees project. or "Borra," is a multi-vintage white made by decanting lees from the bottom of barrels in their 2016 - 2020 vintages. Sustainably farmed, No added sulfites ROSA SANTOS MALVASIA DE COLARES 2015 \$300

The Rose Santos family has been producing wine for over four centuries. The estate has been handed down through the generations from first born son to first born son. This wine is produced from centuries-old vineyards and fermented in used 225 liter barrels. It was aged on total lees for a year and more than 6 years of aging in the bottle until its release.



LISBOA

Western Portugal, near Lisbon

White wines from the Lisboa region of Portugal are known for their diversity, freshness, and approachability. This region encompasses several sub-regions, including Colares, Carcavelos, and Alenquer, each contributing its unique characteristics to the wines. These wines often present vibrant aromas of citrus fruits (such as lemon and orange), green apple, and tropical fruits like pineapple and passion fruit. You may also find floral notes and hints of minerality, especially in wines from coastal sub-regions.

Marta Soares, of Casal Figueira, is a winemaker with and spirit of incomparable strength and resilience. António Augusto Carvalho (1967-2009) was the first and only winemaker to make and bottle 100% varietal Vital. Following his sudden death in 2009, Marta took the reins of their winery and taught herself to make wine. In his memory she kept the project going and renamed the wine "António." Vital is a rare old grape variety from Portugal. *Biodynamic Viticulture*, *No added Sulfites*.

CHAO DO PRADO BRANCO 2020 \$53
Medium Body, Green Apple, Lime Zest, Grass, Flint

Descendents of João Camill Alves have owned Chão do Prado at the northern edge of Bucelas village for over 150 years. They have been growers for four generations, and vinifying since 1991. This wine is incredibly gastronomic and will pair well with just about anything on our menu.



TEJO

Inland Portugal, East of Lisbon

The white wines from Tejo are known for their freshness, balance, and versatility. The region's climate and terroir provide a perfect environment for growing white grape varieties, which create wines that range from crisp and light to more complex and full-bodied styles. Many of the white wines from Tejo showcase vibrant acidity, which gives the wines a refreshing character. They often display notes of citrus fruits, green apple, and tropical fruits like melon and pineapple. Tejo wines can have a subtle mineral edge, particularly those grown in certain soil types that contribute to complexity and a slightly earthy finish.

The Reserva das Pedras wines are made from old vines planted in 1986 in the Charneca area. These iconic vineyards are planted near the banks of the River Tagus, which contributed smooth, water-worn pebbles to the soil and terroir for this remarkable wines.



ALENTEJO

Southern Portugal

White wines from the Alentejo region of Portugal are celebrated for their richness, complexity, and vibrant fruit flavors. This warm and sunny region produces a variety of white wines primarily from indigenous grape varieties such as Antão Vaz, Arinto, and Roupeiro.

SUSANA AVENTURA BRANCA 2022
Susana is known for her adventurous spirit in winemaking, and Aventura Branca features an eclectic mix of grapes that may include Arinto, Alvarinho, or other local varieties. This creative approach results in a wine with vibrant complexity and character. She is committed to sustainable practices, often using organic farming techniques and minimal intervention in the winery. This philosophy not only preserves the environment but also enhances the authenticity of the wine.
SUSANA ESTEBAN TIRA O VÉU 2021\$125 Medium Body, Orange Peel, Peach, Ginger, Clay
Tira o Véu comes from an exceptional vineyard of more than 85-year-old vines in the Serra de Sao Mamede. It was vinified in amphorae until July of the following year. 'O Veu' in the name of this wine refers to the veil (aka voile in the Jura, or flor in Jerez), and the wine ages under a veil of yeast for 6 months. This is a phenomenon that rarely happens, and is more usually found in the production of sherry wines. This wine has intense flavors of citrus oil and herbs, plus a savory, nutty touch from the veil/voile/flor aging.
XXVI TALHAS BRANCO DO TARECO 2023
The tradition of making amphora wine in Portugal is an ancient winemaking that involves fermenting and aging wine in large clay vessels. This tradition has been largely forgotten since the industrialization of winemaking in the 19th and 20th centuries. However, in recent decades, some winemakers have revived this ancient technique. The "Do Tareco" line of wines pays homage to the small wine producers who continued the tradition of producing clay amphora wines in small pots of clay, known locally as "tarecos."
HERDADE DO ROCIM FRESH FROM AMPHORA BRANCO 2022 ······ \$92 Medium Body, Crisp, Ripe Citrus, Peach
The "Fresh" designation highlights the winemaker's aim to create a lively and approachable wine. Expect bright fruit flavors, balanced acidity, and a smooth finish, making it ideal for casual drinking or pairing with various foods. This wine is made using ancient winemaking techniques where the wine is fermented and sometimes aged in clay vessels called amphorae. Certified Organic
FITAPRETA BRANCO 'O'ANCESTRAL' 2022 \$85 Medium-Full Body, Orange Zest, Meyer Lemon, Green Pear, Honey, Brioche
Fitapreta is António Maçanita's estate near the ancient Roman city of Evora, located in the rolling hills of Alentejo. Maçanita works only with indigenous varieties and showcases his estate's terroir through exacting work: farming organically without irrigation, harvesting by hand at night, deliberate bunch sorting in the winery, and native yeast fermentation. Biodynamic Viticulture. The blend features old vines, averaging 50 years of age. Produced with minimal intervention, this wine beautifully expresses the pure aromas and flavors of the Alentejo region. No added Sulfites. Vegan

MAINOVA VERDELHO 2023
Mainova is a Portuguese winery located in the Alentejo region, renowned for its commitment to sustainability and producing wines that authentically express the local terroir. Established in 2019 by José Luís Monteiro and his family, Mainova reflects their dedication to environmental stewardship and quality winemaking. This white wine is perfect for wine lovers who prefer to drink it bone dry. The Verdelho comes very close to this, as it was produced with just 0.5 grams of residual sugar.
ESPORÃO PRIVATE SELECTION GARRAFEIRA WHITE 2016 \$196 Medium-Full body, Grapefruit, Apricots, Toast, Roasted Almonds, White Pepper
Esporão was born in the Alentejo out of the unconditional desire to make the finest wines. This wine is one of the few on our list made from an international grape varietal (Semillion). <i>Certified Organic</i> .
CABEÇAS DO REGUENGO VIRA CABEÇAS BRANCA 2021 \$85 Full Body, Orange, Butter, Honey, Vanilla, Smoke
In 2009, the journalist and wine critic, João Afonso, arrived at the Portalegre region to collect old vine stocks and replant them in a different location. Instead, he decided to leave the ancient vines as they were. He introduced biodiversity with untrellised bush grapevines and olive groves alongside each other believing that it is better for the land and crops. This particular wine is a field blend of up to 15 varieties (Arinto dominant) which was fermented with native yeasts and then aged for 15 months in Estonian and French oak barrels.
SUSANA ESTEBAN FOUDRE 2022 \$152 Medium-Full Body, Complex, Peculiar, Minerality
Foudre comes from an exceptional 80-year-old vineyard located in the Serra de São Mamede and was vinified in a 1961 Foudre Alsatian where it was aged for 16 months. From the first moment, the nose impresses with its intensity and peculiarity, due to the combination of the aroma of the mountain vineyards with the hue of the Foudre. This wine is the second white wine to earn a perfect score from Revista de Vinhos (both wines were produced by Susana).
CARTUXA PERA MANCA BRANCO 2021 \$217 Full Body, Melon, Peach, Lemon, Green herbs, Orange zest
Cartuxa was named for the Cartuxian (Cartuthian) Order of monks, who once had a monastery on the property of Adega Cartuxa. The Pêra-Manca wine was once aboard the ships of Pedro Álvares Cabral, the Portuguese explorer who discovered Brazil in 1500. This historical connection adds to the legendary status of Pêra-Manca today, making it one of the most sought-after wines in Portugal and among collectors worldwide. Cartuxa Pera-Manca Branco, a blend of Antao Vaz and Arinto grapes undergoes meticulous crafting. This is one of Portugal's legendary wines.
CABEÇAS DO REGUENGO ZIZI BRANCO 2022 \$166 Full Body, Quince, Orange Blossom, Pear, Crisp Green Apple, Stones
Cabecas do Reguengo's Zizi is a tightly-wound, almost Chablisien-styled wine that comes from a single vineyard of old, mixed planted bush vines at around 740 meters of elevation. For the aromatics, the producer conducts a very gentle extraction in lagar, with a slow decantation into old wooden vats for fermentation and aging. It's crafted primarily from the Antão Vaz grape, a variety well-suited to the region's hot, dry climate. <i>Organic. Biodynamic.</i>
ADEGA MAREL MANOLITO BRANCO 2021 Full body, Aromatic, Ripe, Orange Marmalade, Cardamom \$95
Adega Marel is nestled in the captivating Alentejo region. This is no ordinary winery; it's a labor of love undertaken by a passionate and youthful team. Adega Marel's inception was driven by a profound appreciation for "Vinho de Talha" (Amphora or Clay Pot Wine) of Amareleja, a profound connection to its people, customs, and traditions. In this wine, made based on two worlds of oenology, the winemaker blended more than grape varieties. The history of this wine begins in the vineyard. They joined Antão Vaz, from a 10-year-old vineyard, with the grapes from our oldest vines - Diagalves, and other local varieties not registered. <i>Organic. Biodynamic</i> .

ESPORÃO RESERVA WHITE 2021
Full Body, Oak, Vanilla, Butter, White Peach, Citrus
Esporão Reserva was the first white wine produced by Esporão, in 1985. Art has accompanied Esporão Reserva since its very beginning. Every year, a new artist is invited to illustrate the labels and each work tells a story. <i>Certified Organic Viticulture. Vegan</i> .
QUINTA DA FONTE SOUTO BRANCO 2020
Full Body, Butter, Oak, Honey, Wet Stones, Lychee, Peach
In Portuguese, 'Fonte' means source of water or fountain, and 'Souto' is a chestnut grove. The combination of the two words in the estate's name symbolizes the abundance of water from its natural springs and beautiful chestnut groves. The Fonte Souto Estate red wine embodies all the strengths of the property's unique terroir: the freshness and balance by the altitude and the concentration, which derives from mature, low-yielding vines.
XXVI TALHAS MESTRE DANIEL TALHA X BRANCO 2022
Full Body, Concentrated, Balanced Minerality, Lemon, Apricot, Mint
The wine is made using the talha method, an ancient technique where the wine ferments and matures in large clay vessels called talhas. Indigenous varietals like Antão Vaz and Rouperio were co-fermented in a single talha, and only 1,000 bottles were produced. <i>Old Vines</i> , <i>Organic</i> , <i>Biodynamic</i>
AZORES ISLANDS
Mid-Atlantic
White wines from the Azores Islands are unique and distinctive, reflecting the islands' volcanic terroir and maritime climate. The region is known for its indigenous grape varieties, particularly Verdelho, Arinto, and Malvasia, which thrive in the rich volcanic soils
ILHA DO PICO VERDELHO 2021
The Pico Volcano, or Pico Mountain, is a stratovolcano of similar typology to other known volcanos like Mount Etna. It is also geologically the youngest island of the Azores archipelago, meaning that the basaltic bed-rock has not had the time to degrade and create soil. These extreme poor soil conditions is what led the cultivation and production of high quality grapes used for winemaking.
AZORES WINE CO INSULA VINUS VERDELHO 2019
The Azores in Portugal is a wild, beautiful, volatile place. The maritime climate of the islands along the Atlantic Ocean is humid and windy and can vary notably from year to year. Winemaker Paulo Machado has an intimate knowledge and relationship with the region as a native to Pico Island. Made from the native Azores varietal, this Verdelho has nice weight with green apple and smokey mushroom notes.
AZORES WINE CO ARINTO DOS AÇORES 2022
António Maçanita and two other partners founded the Azores Wine Company on the island of Pico (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). In the Azores, Pico is an island off the coast of Portugal and is dominated by the volcano Ponta do Pico. The soil is entirely black basalt, which puts enormous stress on the vines, lowering yields. This version of Arinto in the wine has no relation to those on the mainland of Portugal. It is a unique varietal that evolved to adapt to the extreme growing conditions of the region.
ILHA DO PICO TERRANTEZ 2021
From Pico's black volcanic soils, this dry white is among Portugal's finest white wines. It is made from from very scarce (and expensive) Terrantez grapes, then fermented and aged in one large old oak barrel once used in the aging of fortified wines.

MADEIRA

Islands off the northwest coast of Africa

Madeira is a Portuguese wine-producing island located in the Atlantic Ocean, and it's best known for its fortified wines. These white table wines can be quite distinctive and are often made using indigenous grape varieties.

Broadbent is proud to reintroduce Madeira table wines to American wine enthusiasts. These exceptional wines capture the unique terroir and heritage of Madeira. This wine is a blend of Arnsburger (a crossing of two Riesling clones) and Verdelho, which come together to produce a dry, crisp, refreshing white wine from Madeira.

ROSE, ORANGE, AND CHILLED RED WINE



DOURO VALLEY

Northern Portugal along the Douro River

Rosé wines from the Douro Valley are vibrant and expressive, benefiting from the region's rich terroir and a long tradition of wine making. Roses are rarely made here, but when made, they tend to be fruity, with a balance of red fruit flavors and a refreshing acidity. They are made primarily from indigenous grape varieties such as Touriga Naçional, Tinta Roriz and Tinta Barroca, these wines showcase the unique character of the Douro.

MAÇANITA TOURIGA NAÇIONAL EM ROSÉ 2024 \$64
Light Body, Rich, Strawberry, Bing cherry, Cherry Blossom

In 2021 Joana Maçanita was recognized as one of the "100 Most Influential Women in Portugal" by Sábado magazine. She loves to say that "this rosé is what "Touriga Naçional tastes like on the vine, with no makeup."

Uivo, a rising star in the Douro Valley, has been making waves in the Portuguese wine scene since its inception in 2007. This rebellious wine is crafted from an old vineyard that's bursting with a mix of more than 25 different red and white grapes. All these grapes are fermented together with gentle handling and absolutely zero oak, resulting in a wine that's as playful and light as a feather. Think of it as a rosé with attitude, or a spicy vin de soif.

Quinta da Pedra Alta is the only vineyard in the Douro to have three granite markers (Marcos Pombalinos) on its property. These were awarded to the best land during the demarcation of the Port region in 1761. This wine is a blend of six indigenous red and white grape varieties that are cofermented, resulting in a lively, refreshing, and intriguing light red. **Vegan**.



DAO

Central Portugal

A rosé from the Dão region of Portugal is a delightful expression of the area's unique terroir. Typically made from indigenous grape varieties such as Touriga Naçional, Tinta Roriz, and Jaen, these rosés often showcase a beautiful, pale salmon to light pink color

QUINTA DO SAES ROSÉ 2023
Light Body, Juicy, Raspberry, Strawberry

Álvaro Castro was famously resistant to the "internationalization" of Portuguese wine that swept the nation in the 1980s, and through his resistance to trends, helped establish the standard for Dão wines made in the "classic" style. This wine is made solely from free-run juice, allowing for the purest expression of the grape. *Vegan, Certified Organic*.



BEIRA ATLÂNTICO (BAIRRADA)

Central coast, near the Atlantic

Bairrada is one of Portugal's most renowned wine regions, located in the central part of the country, near the Atlantic coast. Rosés from Bairrada reflect the unique terroir and grape varieties of this area and are worth exploring. Whether you prefer a light, easy-drinking style or a more structured, aromatic rosé, Bairrada offers something for every rosé lover.

LUIS PATO BAGA ROSADO 2005 \$125 Medium Body, Rich, Ripe, Strawberry, Dried Flowers, Star Anise

This wine is a very special saignée (a method of rosé winemaking that involves "bleeding" off a portion of red wine in the early stages of fermentation) made with Baga. After bottling, this wine was cellared and ultimately forgotten about for years. Those years of bottle age have done wonders for the wine's structure, and now that it has been rediscovered, it is most certainly ready to drink! *Organic*.



PENINSULA DE SETUBAL

Southern Portugal, near Lisbon

Clarete is a type of wine characterized by its pink to light red color, typically produced through blending red and white grape varieties, and is typically served chilled. Clarete from Setúbal is a distinctive wine that embodies the region's unique terroir. Typically, it's a blend of red and white grapes, often including varieties like Castelão and Muscat. The wine is known for its vibrant color, which can range from a light pink to a deeper ruby hue. On the palate, clarete is usually fresh and fruity, featuring notes of red berries, citrus, & sometimes floral hints.

Herdade do Cebolal was one of the pioneering wine projects on the Alentejo Coast, producing red wines certified with the "Castelão" variety in the late 1930s and 1940s. Last year they developed different styles of wines from the Castelão variety to show the full potential of this unloved and forgotten grape variety in recent years in Portugal.



ALENTEJO

Southern Portugal

Adega de Portalegre Winery creates its wines with a huge eccentricity, singularity and personality, which is reinforced by the numerous national and international awards it has received over more than 60 years. THIS ROSÉ WILL BLOW YOUR MIND. It is produced from a rare grape variety primarily associated with the Alentejo region of Portugal. Specifically, the Portalegre sub-region of Alentejo is known for producing wine from Liona grapes grown on 80-year-old vines. The grapes were whole-bunch vinified and naturally fermented in French oak, then aged for two years.


FITAPRETA A LARANJA MECANICA BRANCO ORANGE WINE

Medium Body, Candied Orange, Apricot, Honey, Saline

Laranja Mecânica means "a mechanical orange," and is a playful reference to Antonio's winemaking process, which differs from the traditional method for making orange wine because he introduces a pressthe "machine." The wine is made exclusively from the second pressing of these grapes and still maintains vinous elegance despite this rustic and atypical technique. Biodynamic Viticulture. No added Sulfites. Vegan

Medium Body, Aromatic, Orange Zest, Olives, Spice

The 2023 Cabeças do Requengo Lagar is an artisanal field blend from two century-old vineyards, Cabeças and Ribeiro de Seda, in Portugal and the Alentejo region. The 'Lagar' wine is a field blend from 100year-old varietals. Organic and Biodynamic.



ALGARVE

Southernmost part of Portugal

Clarete is a type of wine typically produced through blending red and white grape varieties, whereas Palhete is typically produced from a blend of red and white grape varieties that are co-fermented. The key distinction is that palhete typically features a higher proportion of red grapes compared to clarete, giving it a slightly deeper color and more robust flavor profile. Both are typically served chilled.

MORGADO DO QUINTÃO PALHETE 2022______

Full Body, Strawberry, Peach, Melon, Cream

In the early 1800s the Count of Silves, Francisco Manuel Pereira Caldas founded Morgado do Quintão, and at the end of the 19th century, he planted his first vines there. Today, almost 200 years later, his legacy remains. His descendants recruited Joana Maçanita to produce this wine, which is a rare example of a co-ferment of the 2 oldest native grape varieties in Portugal: Negra Mole and Crato Branco. It is dry, full-bodied, and unlike a rosé.



DOURO VALLEY

Northern Portugal along the Douro River

Red wines from the Douro Valley are renowned for their richness, depth, and complexity, reflecting the region's diverse terroir and its long history of wine making. Predominantly made from indigenous grape varieties such as Touriga Naçional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz (Tempranillo), and Tinta Barroca, these wines are often robust and expressive.

PORMENOR CANUCO TINTO 2021
Pormenor Canuco Tinto is widely considered to be one of many wines contributing to the revival of traditional Portuguese winemaking, showcasing Indigenous varieties that may have been overlooked in favor of more internationally recognized grapes in other markets.
LUIS SEABRA XISTO INDIE 2021 \$190 Medium Body, Blackberry, Cassis, Coffee, Vanilla, Leather
For nearly two decades, Luis Seabra has been at the center of a cultural shift in Portuguese winemaking, leading a movement of young, independent winemakers making history by reclaiming historical vineyards, grape varieties, and techniques. Xisto Cru Branco is a single vineyard wine—a rare find in the Douro—that Seabra says is a "magical place that no one can replicate. It is made from grapes from two specific plots with minimal intervention.

LUIS SEABRA XISTO ILIMITADO TINTO 2021 \$64 Medium Body, Red Cherry, Pomegranate, Violet, White Pepper, Vanilla, Oak
For nearly two decades, Luis Seabra has been at the center of a cultural shift in Portuguese winemaking, leading a movement of young, independent winemakers making history by reclaiming historical vineyards, grape varieties, and techniques. Seabra is dedicated to proving that fresh, elegant, terroir-driven still wines can be made in the Douro Valley.
QUINTA DA COSTA DO PINHÃO GRADUAL 2021
Quinta da Costa do Pinhão has been in the same family for more than 6 generations. It has always been a renowned Quinta in the Douro Valley and is reputed for producing Port wines for the most influential houses, frequently becoming part of their Vintage wines. This wine is a captivating field blend that is aged for a year in used French oak barrels prior to bottling. Vegan. Minimal Intervention.
CASTELLO D'ALBA RESERVA TINTO 2022
This wine is produced in Rui Robred Madeira's winery in Sar João da Pesqueira, from a selection of grapes from the best vineyards in the Upper Douro. Castello d'Alba was the first wine he launched in 2000. Madeira has always wanted it to reflect his experiences and vision of a new Douro that combines

cutting-edge winemaking with native grape varieties, creating its own modern and innovative style. This wine is a harmonious blend of Touriga Naçional, Touriga Franca, and Tinta Roriz (Tempranillo), and is

aged for 8 months in seasoned oak barrels.

DONA BERTA TINTO CÃO RESERVA 2020
Medium-Full body, Cherry Cola, Blackberry, Vegetal, Tobacco, Smoke
Around 30 years ago, Hernâni Verdelho began a project to reconvert and improve his wine-growing heritage of old vines, followed by the planting of new vines, most of which are located at Quinta do Carrenho. In addition to the converted vineyards, 2 hectares of centuries-old, pre-phylloxera vineyards are maintained, containing varieties which are no longer included in the current grape variety register.
QUINTA DA COSTA DO PINHÃO GRADUAL 'B SIDE' 2020
Quinta da Costa do Pinhão is a family-owned winery, currently overseen by Miguel Morais, the 7th generation to cultivate the land. The winery occupies prime real estate within the Douro Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famed for its dramatic beauty and terraced vineyards. This wine is a blend of Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz grown on both old and young vines. It is aged for a year in used French oak, followed by 2 years in stainless steel before bottling. Vegan. Minimal Intervention.
QUANTA TERRA GRANDE RESERVA 2020
Quanta Terra, a symbol of passion and dedication, celebrates its 20-year journey in the Douro region. Founded by Celso Pereira and Jorge Alves, both pioneers in their craft, the brand started as a mirage in the 90s, born from a shared vision during their time at Caves Transmontanas, a well-known Duoro producer making some of the best Portuguese sparkling wine in the Méthode champenoise (check out our sparkling section for these wines, too!)
CASA FERREIRINHA QUINTA DA LEDA 2018 \$183 Full Body, Blackberry, Black Plum, Cedar, Vanilla, Cocoa, Cassis
Quinta do Leda is particularly known for its top-tier red wines, often characterized by their intensity, complexity, and ability to age gracefully. This is the flagship wine of the estate and is a perfect expression of the Douro Valley's terroir. They are luxurious, well-structured, and age-worthy wines. Single estate, Vegan
MAÇANITA É SOUSÃO OU SERÁ VINHÃO TINTO 2020 \$184 Full Body, Black Plum, Blueberries, Black Pepper, Violets, Lingering Minerality
In 2021 Joana Maçanita was recognized as one of the "100 Most Influential Women in Portugal" by Sábado magazine. She produced this wine from Sousão, which is also planted widely in Vinho Verde and is called 'Vinhão'. This wine's name asks "Is it Sousão or will it be Vinhão?" referring to the different styles of wine produced in Vinho Verde and Douro Valley. Will it be a bold, intense Sousão, or a light, refreshing Vinhão? Joana has left it for you to decide.
PORMENOR TRILHO TINTO 2019 Full Body, Raspberries, Violets, Oak, Mocha \$171
The 2013 vintage is rooted in a fierce belief in the potential for Douro wines to show freshness, restrained alcohol, and elegance. Pormenor found and secured incredibly rare vineyard real estate, with vines ranging from 45 to 100+ years, primarily in the Douro Superior. This wine is a fresh and elegant example of a Douro red wine.
CASA FERREIRINHA 'VINHA GRANDE' DOURO TINTO 2021
Casa Ferreirinha has carried the torch for creative, quality winemaking in the Douro, becoming the region's most historic and iconic house. In the 1950's, Ferreira's technical director, Fernando Nicolau de Almeida, set out to make the highest quality unfortified wines in the Douro. He aimed to produce elegant, top-quality wines with the aging potential of Vintage Port. This wine has powerful and firm tannins, a balanced acidity and a smooth finish.

QUINTA DA COSTA DO PINHÃO PELADOSA 2020
Quinta da Costa do Pinhão is a winery on the rise, quickly gaining recognition for its terroir-driven, hand-crafted wines. This wine is a blend of Alicante Bouschet, Tinta Roriz, and Tinta Carvalha grown on 80+ year-old vines. It is fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged for 21 months in French oak barrels prior to bottling. <i>Vegan. Minimal Intervention</i> .
VINILOURENÇO PAI HORÁCIO GRANDE RESERVA TINTO 2019
This wine is a field blend of five different grape varietals indigenous to the Douro region. The vines that produced the fruit are 80-100 years old, contributing to its almost opaque color and incredible flavor intensity. Though bold, this wine has a velvety texture and a luxuriously round mouthfeel. Every year, to honor the founder of their company, "Father Horacio" Vinilourenço produces a blend of the best fruits for the harvest in his name. We recommend decanting this wine.
CASA FERREIRINHA CALLABRIGA TINTO 2021 \$108 Full Body, Velvety, Vanilla, Tobacco, Balsamic, Blackberry, Pine Needles
Callabriga is predominantly made with Touriga Franca blended with smaller amounts of Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz, all typical varieties indigenous to the Douro wine region. It is an intense, yet elegant wine that borrows its name from a Roman fortified settlement in the Douro Valley—an homage to the structural power of the wine. Sustainable Viticulture. Vegan.
CASA FERREIRINHA "BARCA VEHLA" TINTO 2011

LAGAR DE DAREI TINTO 2019
Casa de Darei is a third-generation estate of the Ruivo family and a gorgeous 150-hectare property nestled in the Dão Valley. BAIRRADA

Central coast, near the Atlantic

Red wines from the Bairrada region of Portugal are known for their robustness, depth, and distinctive character. This region is particularly famous for its use of the Baga grape, which thrives in the area's clay-limestone soils and cool Atlantic influences, resulting inwines that are both powerful and elegant.

V PURO DORAVANTE TINTO 2017
V Puro is the passion project of two long-time friends, oenologists, and viticulturalists, Nuno Mira do Ó and João Soares. The pair love old vines, and have a passion for hunting down and working with old vine Baga. Their discovery of an ancient vineyard in Bairrada with vines between 80 to 120 years of age sealed their partnership. The duo seeks to unlock the fresh, intense flavors only possible from old vines.
LUIS PATO BAGA / TOURIGA NAÇIONAL BLEND 2023
Luis Pato is often referred to as a pioneer in the revival of Baga, championing its potential as a serious varietal. This blend not only showcases the rich heritage of Portuguese winemaking but also emphasizes the innovative spirit of modern producers who are keen to blend tradition with contemporary styles. Touriga Naçional is widely considered one of the premier winemaking grapes in Portugal.
LUIS PATO VINHA BARROSA 2021\$182 Medium-Full body, Rustic, Fresh Cherries, Black Plum, Eucalyptus, Leather
From Luis Pato's centenarian single vineyard - a small, enchanting clearing surrounded by pine and eucalyptus forest that have imparted their flavors and fragrances on the wine. The ancient vines of the Barrosa vineyard provide some of Bairrada's greatest bottlings, and recent vintages are spectacular. These old, low-yielding Baga vines produce wines of intensity and structure.
CAVES SÃO JOÃO QUINTA DO POÇO DO LOBO 1996
Caves S. Joao, established in 1920, became a dominant force in Portuguese wine-making in the early 20th century with their houses Porta dos Cavaleiros in Dao and Frei João in Bairrada. In 2013, the Costa family, owners of the estate, decided to open their cellars and offer the old vintages in stock, ranging from 1959 to 2000. Caves S. Joao is the only winery in Portugal offering library releases of still wines commercially with vintages going back to the 1950s.
NIEPOORT LAGAR DE BAIXO 2019
The red Lagar de Baixo is the result of a combination of very old vines and younger vines: complex, and serious, but with some youth and grip. The 2017 Lagar de Baixo is our most classic wine from Quinta de Baixo and the wine that best reflects the Bairrada terroir. It is fermented in lagares and aged in used barrels. Old vine. Vegan.
LUIS PATO VINHA BARRIO 2000
The Vinha Barrio vineyard is the second smallest vineyard at the Pato estate with 90-plus-year-old vines planted in chalky clay. It seldom produces enough fruit to be bottled as a single vineyard wine, making this wine a rare treat for Portuguese wine lovers. The high acid, high tannin Baga grape is the backbone of all red Bairrada wines, and Pato is widely considered to be the father of Baga wines. This is a full-

body, structured wine, which Julia Harding, Master of Wine, described as "muscular, but not a

Sidónio de Sousa is renowned for having among the oldest, some of the best Baga vineyards in Bairrada. He continues to make his wine traditionally, resulting in juicy, refined wines with good fruit and aged in old Portuguese oak, rare nowadays, even in Portugal. Baga typically produces wines that are dry, fuller in body, and in both acid and tannin. This wine was aged for 2 years in barrel and one year in bottle prior to it's release.



BEIRA INTERIOR

Central Portugal

Beira Interior is less well-known than other Portuguese wine regions but has been gaining recognition for its quality wines, often showcasing the region's rich history and unique agricultural heritage. It is known for producing a range of styles of red wines. Full-bodied Reds are often made from Indigenous varieties like Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz, and tend to be rich and complex, with dark fruit flavors and struc-tured tannins. Light to Medium-bodied Red wines emphasize freshness and fruitiness, making them approachable and versatile.

BEYRA TINTO 2022 \$63 Medium Body, Blackberries, Strawberry, Cassis, Simple

The Beyra Wines have the character of Beira Interior: wines of great complexity resulting from the combination of aromatic intensity, minerality, and freshness. Beyra tinto offers an unoaked expression of crunchy berry fruit and spice, with super acidity.

BEYRA RESERVA TINTO 2022 \$73 Medium Body, Blackberries, Nutmeg, Vanilla, Toast, Oak
Grapes are grown in vineyards located on the plateau area of the Beira Interior wine region, at an average altitude of 700 meters, in schist soils. The vineyards feature native varieties that are perfectly adapted to the environmental and climatic characteristics created by the altitude, chosen one by one depending on the vintage. The Beyra Reserva is a delightful Tempranillo-based blend crafted in a fruit-forward, approachable style. Fruity berries and spice, subtle notes of vanilla, and toast from a small proportion of barrel aging, with very elegant and discreet minerality.
LUIS PATO QUINTA DO MOINHO 2000
Luis Pato is often referred to as a pioneer in the revival of Baga, championing its potential as a serious varietal. This wine is produced from 100% Baga planted in 1989 on soils with slightly more clay and surrounded by a eucalyptus forest. The Moinho typically has darker fruit and a lovely herbaceous character that gives it an almost Cabernet-like quality. Some feel, when aged, these wines can be a dead ringer for cooler vintage left bank Bordeaux.



COLARES

Atlantic coast, near Lisbon

Wines produced in Colares are a rare and unique Portuguese delight. The Colares wine region is located in the municipality of Sintra, near Lisbon. The region is known for its exceptional, historic vineyards that are situated near the Atlantic coast, producing wines with a distinctive character. Red Colares wines are typically full-bodied and well structured, with flavors of dark fruits, earth, and a slight minerality. These wines, especially those made with Ramisco, are known for their aging potential, often upewards of 50 years. With their acidity and tannin structure, these wines can evolve and improve with time, developing more complex aromas and flavors..

HUGO MENDES LISBOA CASTELAO 2023	\$64
Hugo Mendes emphasizes traditional winemaking practices, often incorporating minimal intervention to allow the true character of the Castelão grape and its terroir to shine through. In keeping with Portuguese tradition, this wine is a complex blend of both red and white grape varieties. TEJO

Inland Portugal, East of Lisbon

The Tejo region in Portugal, formerly known as the "Ribatejo" region, is located in central Portugal, surrounding the Tejo River (which gives the region its name). It's one of the country's oldest and most diverse wine-producing areas, with a long history of viticulture that dates back to Roman times. Red wines from Tejo often have a full-bodied profile with balanced acidity. The wines can be fruit-forward, with notes of red and black berries, and may also exhibit earthy, spicy, and herbal characteristics.

Portugal is known for producing complex blends from Indigenous varietals, making this single-varietal wine is a rare treat! Trincadeira typically produces deeply colored wines with herby, spicy notes and a propensity to age well. Quinta do Mouro was chosen as Alentejo's Best Wine Producer in 2015 by Wine Magazine. That same year, in The Wine Advocate, Mark Squires wrote "All the tastings that I had in Alentejo lead me to one conclusion: Quinta do Mouro is the best winemaker of the region. You can't ignore it."

Southern Portugal, near Lisbon

The Peninsula de Setúbal, located in southern Portugal, is renowned for producing exceptional red wines. The red wines from this region can range from easy-drinking, fresh wines to more complex, full-bodied styles. Many are characterized by ripe berry flavors, earthy tones, and a touch of spice. They are often balanced, with moderate acidity and smooth tannins.

QUINTA DO PILOTO TINTO RESERVA 2021\$121

Full Body, Intense, Black Plum, Bramble, Black Pepper, Lavender, Oak

Quinta do Piloto is a winery with a rich history spanning four generations, deeply entwined with the evolution of its hometown, Palmela, over a century. The family proudly upholds its heritage, preserving original cellars and estates. This single-varietal wine is made from Castelão, which is known for producing fuller-body, structured wines. To add complexity, it is aged for 16 months in French oak barrels followed by 12 months in the bottle before release.



ALENTEJO

Southern Portugal

Red wines from the Alentejo region of Portugal are celebrated for their richness, fruit-forward character, and accessibility. This warm, sun-soaked region is known for its diverse range of grape varieties, including indigenous types like Aragonez (Tempranillo), Trincadeira, Alicante Bouschet, and occasionally international varieties like Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon.

HERDADE DO ROCIM FRESH FROM AMPHORA TINTO 2022
The "Fresh" designation highlights the winemaker's aim to create a lively and approachable wine. Expect bright fruit flavors, balanced acidity, and a smooth finish, making it ideal for casual drinking or pairing with a variety of foods. This wine is made using ancient winemaking techniques where the wine is fermented and sometimes aged in clay vessels called amphorae. Certified Organic
SUSANA ESTEBAN AVENTURA TINTO 2022 \$83 Medium Body, Fresh, Blackberry, Black Plum, Leather, Potting Soil, Tobacco
In 2012 Susana Esteban was awarded the most prestigious prize a winemaker can receive in Portugal - the title of "Winemaker of the Year" by Revista de Vinhos magazine. To date, she has been the only woman to have been awarded this distinction. Aventura was one of the first wines Esteban produced, and while it has evolved over the years, it remains an elegant and imminently gastronomic wine. This vintage gives fresh fruit with floral notes, balanced by a woody earthiness due to 16mos aging in french oak.
CABECAS DO REGUENGO LUAR TINTO 2022
Cabeças do Reguengo is a small project focused on pre-phylloxera vines at high elevations in Portalegre, a town in eastern Alentejo near the Spanish border. The wines are made with minimal intervention yet leave the cellar pristine in quality. This wine is produced from Trincadeira, which is a very temperamental variety. It gives spicy, grassy, and earthy notes.
ADEGA MAREL TONICO TINTO TALHA 2021 \$143 Medium Body, Bold, Ripe, Sour Cherry, Dried Herbs
This wine leads with crushed strawberry and cherry jam, followed by herbal nuances of thyme and laurel. The finish is marked by earthy notes and a light smokiness. The tannins are soft, but present, adding texture to the wine. This wine is fermented and aged in clay amphora which softens the mouthfeel of this wine, despite extended alcoholic maceration.
FITAPRETA VINHOS A TOURIGA VAI NUA 2022
A Touriga Vai Nua, or "The Touriga Goes Naked," is one playful example of António Macanita's skill: he takes the "typical" warmth and ripeness of Alentejo fruit and creates a completely novel expression out of Portugal's king of grapes, Touriga Naçional. The combination of partial carbonic maceration and a quick 3-months aging in stainless steel create an expression of Touriga that is light on its feet and versatile.
FITAPRETA TINTA CARVALHA 2021
The name tells a story: Chão dos Eremitas, "Chão", an old term for flat areas, and "Eremitas" referring to the Hermit monks of São Paulo's order. Here, there is evidence of uninterrupted wine production since the 14th century. Archeology goes further, discovering the only Phoenician wine amphora of Portugal's inland, dating to the 8th century BC. This links this place to wine about 900 years before the arrival of the Romans. Biodynamic Viticulture. No added Sulfites. Vegan.

QUINTA DA FONTE SOUTO TINTO 2019
In Portuguese 'Fonte' means source of water or fountain, and 'Souto' is a chestnut grove. The combination of the two words in the estate's name symbolizes the abundance of water from the estate's natural springs and its beautiful chestnut groves. The Fonte Souto Estate red wine embodies all the strengths of the property's unique terroir: the freshness and balance afforded by the altitude and the concentration, which derives from mature, low-yielding vines.
CARTUXA PERA MANCA TINTO 2018
History associates this name Pêra-Manca to the friars of the Espinheiro Convent in Évora, who owned vineyards in the 15th and 16th centuries. Their wines would become very famous, to the extent that Pedro Álvares Cabral took some barrels with him on the expedition that discovered Brazil. The Pêra-Manca Tinto is particularly revered for its richness, complexity, and longevity.
SUSANA ESTEBAN PROCURA TINTO 2017
Susana Esteban is known for her adventurous spirit in winemaking. Procura Tinto is the aftereffect of her never-ending pursuit of age-old vineyards in São Mamede's Range, which she has been recovering throughout the years. It was matured for 24 months inside worn French oak casks, brought from Burgundy. This wine is almost black color with Intense and ripe fruit notes, a deep minerality, and a surprising vegetal overtone.
CARTUXA EVORA TINTO RESERVA 2017
Blackberry, Black Cherry, Leather, Tobacco, Smoke, Oak
Cartuxa is a non-profit company started in 1963 by the Eugenio de Almeida Foundation. It was named for the Cartuxian (Cartuthian) Order of monks, who once had a monastery on the property where Adega Cartuxa is located. Leather and vanilla aromas confirm the 15 months of wood aging. This is now a mature wine, rich in black fruits that are showing secondary flavors.
ESPORÃO RESERVA TINTO 2021
Esporão Reserva was the first red wine produced by Esporão, in 1985. Art has accompanied Esporão Reserva since its very beginning. Every year, a new artist is invited to illustrate the labels and each work tells a story. This label was illustrated by Alexandre Conefrey.
DONA MARIA GRANDE RESERVA 2018 \$168 Vanilla, Chocolate, Blackberry, Leather, Mint
Situated in Alentejo, this palace-like 18th-century house is a landmark, not only for its beauty but also for its history and the top-quality wine produced there. Wine has been produced in this estate for more than 150 years, and it has been restored, keeping the 19th-century marble "lagares" where selected grapes are vinified using the traditional foot treading method. It gives aromas of wild fruit, spices, and mint. The palate is intense and well-rounded, showing silky tannins and a persistent finish.
DONA MARIA GRANDE RESERVA 2018
Situated in Alentejo, this palace-like 18th century house is a landmark, not only for its beauty but also for its history and the top-quality wine produced there. Wine has been produced in this estate for more than 150 years, and it has been restored, keeping the 19th century marble "lagares" where selected grapes are vinified using the traditional foot treading method. It gives aromas of wild fruit, spices and mint. The palate is intense and well-rounded, showing silky tannins and a persistent finish.
TAPADA COELHEIROS VINHA DO TACO 2014\$170 Full body, Intense, Cassis, Dark Chocolate, Leather, Tobacco, Baking Spices
Vinha do Taco is produced entirely from Petit Verdot sourced from the Vinha do Taco Vinyeard. Tapada Coelheiros only produces this wine in exceptional years and in limited quantities. Petit Verdot is more often than not used as a blending grape, giving tannin, body, and color intensity to a wine. Age has softened the edges of this powerful wine, but we still recommend decanting this wine.

JULIO B. BASTOS ALICANTE BOUSCHET 2018. \$248 Full Body, Kirsch, Blackberry, Bell Pepper, Dark Chocolate, Black Truffle, Black Coffee
This is one of the few single-varietal wines on our list, and boy is it a big one! Alicante Bouchet is known for producing big, boozy, dark red wines, and this one lives up to that reputation. This wine was foot-trodden and fermented in marble lagars, then aged for 14 months in French oak before bottling. We recommend decanting this wine.
QUINTA DE LEMOS TOURIGA DO BOSQUE 2015
Chock-full of Indigenous grape varieties, Quinta de Lemos creates wines that expertly display a balance between tradition and modernity. Recognized for its release of older vintages, this sustainably farmed estate in the Dão showcases some of the most elegant wines from the oldest region in Portugal. This single-varietal wine is produced from Touriga Nacional, which is known for producing bold, full-body, structured wines. It is fermented and aged in French oak to enhance its structure and complexity.
HEREDADE MOUCHÃO TINTO 2016 \$177 Full Body, Concentrated, Jammy, Blackberry, Olives, Mint
This wine is the Mouchão estate's flagship wine in all its typicity. It is a blend of Alicante Bouschet and Trincadeira, resulting in this rich, dark-fruited, yet supremely elegant wine. Herdade do Mouchão continues to be managed and worked on by the descendants of the original family and the entire winemaking process remains virtually unchanged, preserving the traditional harvest by hand and the fermentation of the grapes in stone presses, using foot treading.
CARTUXA SCALA COELI TINTO 2020 \$200 Full Body, Leather, Smoke, Blackberry, Tobacco Leaf
This wine takes its name from the Santa Maria Scala Coeli Monastery where monks lived in silence and daily prayer. It is only produced in exceptional years from grape varieties not typically found in the Alentejo region. One of our few single-varietal wines, this wine is made from 100% Touriga Nacional, which is known for producing intense, full-bodied, and well-structured wines. It is aged for 15 months in new french oak before bottling.
CARTUXA SCALA COELI RESERVA TINTO 2019
Cartuxa Scala Coeli Reserva is one of the only wines on our list produced from an international grape varietal, as they have not gained a foothold in Portugal's wine industry. This wine takes its name from the Santa Maria Scala Coeli Monastery where monks lived in silence and daily prayer. It is only produced

in exceptional years from grape varieties not typically found in the Alentejo region. 100% Cabernet Saugivgnon. After fermentation it is aged for 15 months in new French barrels, followed by 24 months in the bottle prior to release.

AZORES ISLANDS

Mid-Atlantic

Most red wines from the Azores are made in a medium-bodied style, with vibrant acidity that balances the fruitiness. Because of the cooler climate and volcanic terroir, these wines often have an earthy character and can show some minerality, which gives them an edge over red wines from warmer regions.

AZORES WINE CO ISABELLA A PROIBIDA 2019\$94

Juicy, Strawberry, Cranberry, Saline, Meat, Seaweed, Wet Stone

Just one short decade after launching Fitapreta Vinhos in Alentejo, António Maçanita and two other partners founded the Azores Wine Company in Pico. Pico is dominated by the volcano Ponta do Pico, Portugal's highest mountain. Vines are the only crop to speak of on Pico, as other plant life has a difficult time surviving. Antonio has rescued an old plot of this unique varietal, Isabella, for a passion project, to show that this grape is capable of making spectacular wine.

FORTIFIED WINES



PORTO

coastal city in northwest Portugal

The Douro Valley, where port wine is produced, is situated upstream from Porto. The city is a major center for the port wine trade, with numerous wine cellars and tasting rooms located along the riverside in the Vila Nova de Gaia area.

GRAHAM'S SIX GRAPES RUBY PORT
Six Grapes typically sees a rather shorter period in wooden barrels than other Reserve Ruby Ports, with our blending team seeking to preserve its youthful, blackberry fruit character and the fresh aromas of cassis and liquorice.
VIERA DE SOUSA 10 YEAR TAWNY PORT
The Viera De Sousa family has been producing Port wine for at least for 5 generations All their wines are produced with grapes from the 4 Quintas of the family, which are almost 60 hectares in Douro Valley.
QUINTA DA PEDRA ALTA 'ALTA NO 10' TEN-YEAR-OLD TAWNY PORT
Quinta da Pedra Alta is the only vineyard in the Douro to have three granite markers (Marcos Pombalinos) on its property. These were awarded to the best land during the demarcation of the Port region in 1761. Alta No. 10 is an elegant, luscious, complex Tawny Port, made in our traditional granite lagars, aged in old casks.
MENERES 40YR TAWNY PORT
Meneres, a revered name in the Port wine industry, has been crafting top-quality Ports since its inception. This line of ports was originally named after family ancestor Arnaldo Menéres. It was patiently matured for 40 years in seasoned oak casks and then blended and bottled.
PORTO DOS SANTOS 10 YEAR WHITE PORT
For years, this Porto Dos Santos produced excellent wines, but at the beginning of the 20th century the brand was sold to another port company the brand fell into oblivion. In 2022 a descendant of the founders decided to revive the brand. This wine undergoes a longer fermentation than the usual port fermentation which reduces the sugar by up to a half of what is often customary in the region. This results in a dryer style than usual which leads to enormous richness and aromatic elegance in these wines.
QUINTA DA PEDRA ALTA PEDRA Nº 03 WHITE PORT
Quinta da Pedra Alta Reserva Branco is a complex, textured, barrel fermented Douro white made from a blend of indigenous premium grape varieties from our highest vineyards. Pedra No. 03 is a fresh,



CARCAVELOS

Lisbon Region

Carcavelos is a historic fortified wine, once highly sought after by European nobility. These wines are known for their rich amber color, complex aromas of dried fruit, nuts, and spices, and a balanced sweetness complemented by a vibrant acidity.

Historically, Carcavelos wines have been highly regarded, particularly its fortified wines, which were once as prized as Port and Madeira in international markets. With the revival of interest in Carcavelos wines in recent years, this unique wine region is slowly making a comeback and is well worth exploring for wine enthusiasts interested in Portugal's rich winemaking history. Villa Oeiras is the sole remaining producer of Carcavelos



MADEIRA

Islands off the northwest coast of Africa

Best known for its fortified Madeira wines, which range from dry to sweet and are known for their incredible longevity. The wines have complex flavors of caramel, nuts, dried fruits, and spices. Key grape varieties include Sercial, Verdelho, Bual, and Malvasia.

The Henriques & Henriques Terrantez 20-Year-Old is a special bottling that showcases the unique characteristics of this grape. With two decades of aging, it typically offers rich flavors of dried fruits, nuts, spices, and a distinctive acidity that balances its sweetness. Terrantez is the rarest of Madeira's noble varieties.

In 1998, the Rare Wine Co. began working with Vinhos Barbeito's owner, Ricardo Freitas, to create a series of Madeiras reflecting the madeiras that enchanted our forefathers. To emphasize America's deep historical connection to Madeira, each wine in the series is named for a U.S. city where Madeira was popular in the 18th and 19th centuries. This is the driest wine in the series and a wine that has been served throughout meals in America for nearly 300 years. Alice Feiring described as "like a salted caramel without its sugar."

In 1998, the Rare Wine Co. began working with Vinhos Barbeito's owner, Ricardo Freitas, to create a series of Madeiras reflecting madeiras that enchanted our forefathers. To emphasize America's deep historical connection to Madeira, each wine in the series is named for a U.S. city where Madeira was popular in the 18th and 19th centuries. MUSCATEL DE SETÚBAL

Southern Portugal, near Lisbon

Muscatel de Setúbal (or Moscato di Setúbal) is a prestigious and aromatic fortified wine from the Setúbal Peninsula, located south of Lisbon. It is made primarily from the Muscat grape variety, which is known for its sweet, floral, and citrusy notes. Muscatel is fortified with a neutral grape spirit, which stops fermentation and preserves the natural sugars, resulting in a sweet and often higher that typical alcohol content. It was first made popular by the famous Portuguese winemaker José Maria da Fonseca, who is credited with perfecting the production of this wine in the 19th century.

Moscatel de Setúbal "Excellent" is the result of intense work over more than 100 years shared between the vineyard and the winery. After fermentation, this wine was aged in a group of very special barrels, where it evolved for decades.

SHERRY (JEREZ)

Southern Spain

Sherry is a fortified wine from the Jerez region of southern Spain, which includes the cities of Jerez de la Frontera, Sanlúcar de Barrameda, and El Puerto de Santa María. It is unique because it undergoes a special aging process known as the solera system, a complex method of blending and aging wine in a series of barrels. Sherry has historically been associated with more traditional drinking habits, but in recent years it has enjoyed a resurgence, especially among sommeliers and in modern Spanish cuisine.

BARBADILLO PEDRO XIMENEZ SHERRY Dried Figs, Butterscotch, Hazelnut, Cassis

PX, as it is better known in its abbreviated form, is the very richest and stickiest style of Sherry to be found. The Pedro Ximénez grape is picked and sun-dried to produce very concentrated sugars in the raisined grape. The result is an ultra sweet wine with a treacly texture and flavour. It is often enjoyed poured over vanilla ice cream. Barbadillo, Founded in 1821, is without question Sanlucar de Barrameda's most iconic producer of Sherry.
